Day 1: Arrival in Lyon

- Arrival in Lyon (Airport or train station)

You are welcomed by your driver guide

- **Private transfer to a typical Bouchon Lyonnais.**

Discovery of the dishes from Lyon in this traditional restaurant with a Meilleur Ouvrier de France for chef.

- **Private guided tour of Vieux-Lyon to Fourvière**

The esplanade of Fourvière offers a magnificent uninterrupted view of Lyon. The basilica of Notre Dame, built at the end of the 19th century, is a real eyecatcher. Don't walk by without taking a look inside, because the interior is just as remarkable as the outside. Your walk then takes you down towards Old Lyon, either through the Rosaire gardens or via the Roman theatres. Do not forget that Lugdunum was founded on the hill of Fourvière in 43 BC. At the bottom of the hill, the Renaissance town stretches out along the banks of the river Saône. Walk through a few of the narrow streets and the squares and delve into the "traboules" to discover hidden courtyards, galleries and wells...

- **Installation in your hotel 4 **** Hotel de Fourvière**

Ideally located on the top of the Roman amphitheaters, close to the Basilica, the Fourvière Hotel reinvents the former convent of the Visitation built by Bossan in 1854 to make you live in Lyon a unique hotel experience.

- **Spa access**

A well-being area "Fourvière Les Bains" articulated outside, with 25m heated swim lane, and inside with steam room, spa, ice fountain and thematic showers.

- **Dinner cruise along the Rhône of the Saône**

- **Transfer to the Beaujolais wine region**

Known all over the world for its vineyards, the Pays Beaujolais attracts not only wine lovers, but also invites to discover charming villages with golden stones.

- **Installation at the Château de Pizay 4 ******

Surrounded by 80 hectares of forest and vineyards, Château de Pizay is located in Beaujolais. Dating back to the 11th century, its 4-star rooms and suites overlook a French-style garden, a heated outdoor pool, vineyard or castle.

- **Spa access and wellness center**

Château de Pizay is renowned for its award-winning 1000 m² spa. It offers a sauna, a steam room and a range of massages and wellness, multisensory or hydrotherapy treatments.

- **Discovery of the wine workshop area**

Share a playful moment over the 8 workshops of initiation to oenology. Discover the BA-BA tasting with quizzes on color, aroma, flavor, interaction between flavors, tannins, the difference between aromas and flavors, undergrowth and aging some wine...

- **Gourmet dinner at the site**

The gourmet restaurant serves seasonal menus prepared with fresh produce from the local market. Meals are accompanied by fine wines produced on site or from the bicentennial wine cellar.

The Beaujolais vineyard, which covers an area of 22,500 hectares, has 12 appellations. Both Appellations Beaujolais and Beaujolais Villages, and the 10 Crus, which are Brouilly, Chénas, Chiroubles, Côte-de-Brouilly, Fleurie, Juliéas, Morgon, Windmill, Regnié and Saint-Amour, are the fame of the vineyard. Famous all over the world, the Beaujolais Nouveau is celebrated every third Thursday of November



- **"Food and wine pairing" workshop in winemaker domain**

Almost everything about the history of the wine. Commentary on different methods: white, red, rosé, organic viticulture. Tasting tips: Know how to serve, open, and enjoy a wine, for greater pleasure. An introduction to tasting with 3 wines from the estate. -The color and its revelations. -the main aromas of the wines. -balances in mouths. Practical application food and wine pairing: -Farm cheese is served with white wine, then a cold meat with 2 red wines.

- **Discover the villages of the golden stones**

Golden shades of houses, castles and churches illuminate the landscape. Among 39 villages of the Pays des Pierres Dorées, some villages, such as Bagnols, Oingt, Jarnioux, Ternand and Theizé, are to be discovered!
