Day 3 -Louvre

Day 4 – Eiffel Tower



AM: Ascend to the second floor of the Eiffel Tower and immerse yourself in the breathtaking view of Paris.

A true symbol of Paris and an icon of France, the Eiffel Tower was masterfully crafted by Gustave Eiffel for the Universal Exhibition of 1889. Today, it stands as one of the most visited landmarks in the world.

Exploring the Eiffel Tower is an extraordinary experience, from wandering through its historical gardens to gazing out at the mesmerizing vistas of Paris from its summit. On the first floor, the glass floor beneath your feet offers an exhilarating sensation of walking high above the ground. Whether you visit in the warmth of summer or the chill of winter, you can take a moment to savor the view from the terrace, perched 57 meters above the earth.

As you reach the second floor, a feast for the eyes unfolds before you. Behold the beauty of the Louvre, the grandeur of the Grand Palais, the meandering loops of the Seine, the charm of Montmartre, the majesty of the Invalides, and the grace of Notre-Dame. Your visual journey is complemented by delightful culinary options, including the Michelin-starred restaurant Le Jules Verne, the Pierre Hermé Paris macaroon bar, and a convenient takeaway spot.

PM: Say Goodbye to Paris and enjoy a scenic drive to the Loire Valley.

Day 5 – Chambord and Chenonceau Castles



Immerse yourself in a fairy-tale experience, stroll through enchanting settings of Christmas, and take part in extraordinary workshops and tours.

Meet your private guide at your hotel.

Drive first to **Chambord.** In the colossal Chateau de Chambord, you can appreciate the work of Leonardo da Vinci and great French architects. The Château de Chambord is one of the most widely recognized of the Loire Chateau with its distinctive French Renaissance architecture which, in the 16th century, blended French medieval design with classical Renaissance structures. The chateau which was constructed by King Francis 1 of France as a hunting lodge is surrounded by 13,000 acres of wooded park which is a game reserve. The chateau is most noted for its extraordinary roofscape and open double-spiral staircase.

Then drive to Chenonceau:

The history of the Château de Chenonceau is defined by an almost uninterrupted succession of women who built, embellished, protected, restored and saved it. The first château was a medieval château dating from the 12th and 13th centuries, of which only the dungeon remains: the Tour des Marques.

Night in Blois or Chambord

- → Private day tour to Chenonceau and Chambord castles, tickets included.

Day 6 – Blois – Paris



AM: Built on the hillside, Blois is a city made for walking, with stairs, slopes and climbs everywhere. Forming a bank of the Loire, it offers a magnificent view of the Royal River and the Jacques Gabriel Bridge, built in the eighteenth century. Don't miss the Renaissance mansions of rue du Puits-Châtel, or the "Maison des acrobates" on Place Saint-Louis, one of the oldest buildings in Blois dating back to the reign of Louis XI. It was crowned "The most beautiful house in France" in 1960.

To allow you to discover the city at your own pace, four pedestrian circuits marked with bronze studs in the ground which guide you around the different districts: the surroundings of the château and the royal gardens, Puits-Châtel, the surroundings of the old abbeys, and the left bank with its magnificent panorama.

Pm: Drive back to Paris.
